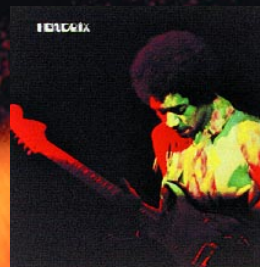
- **Slash**, the hard-rocking guitarist from Guns N' Roses;
