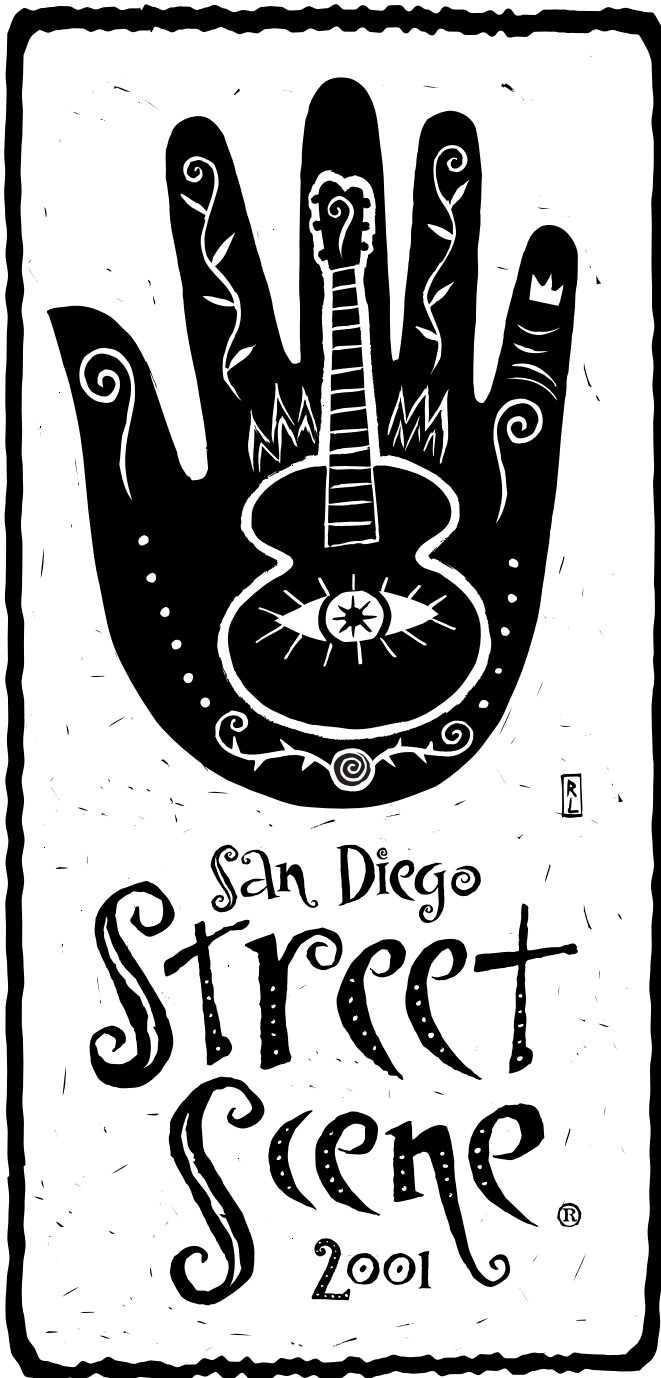

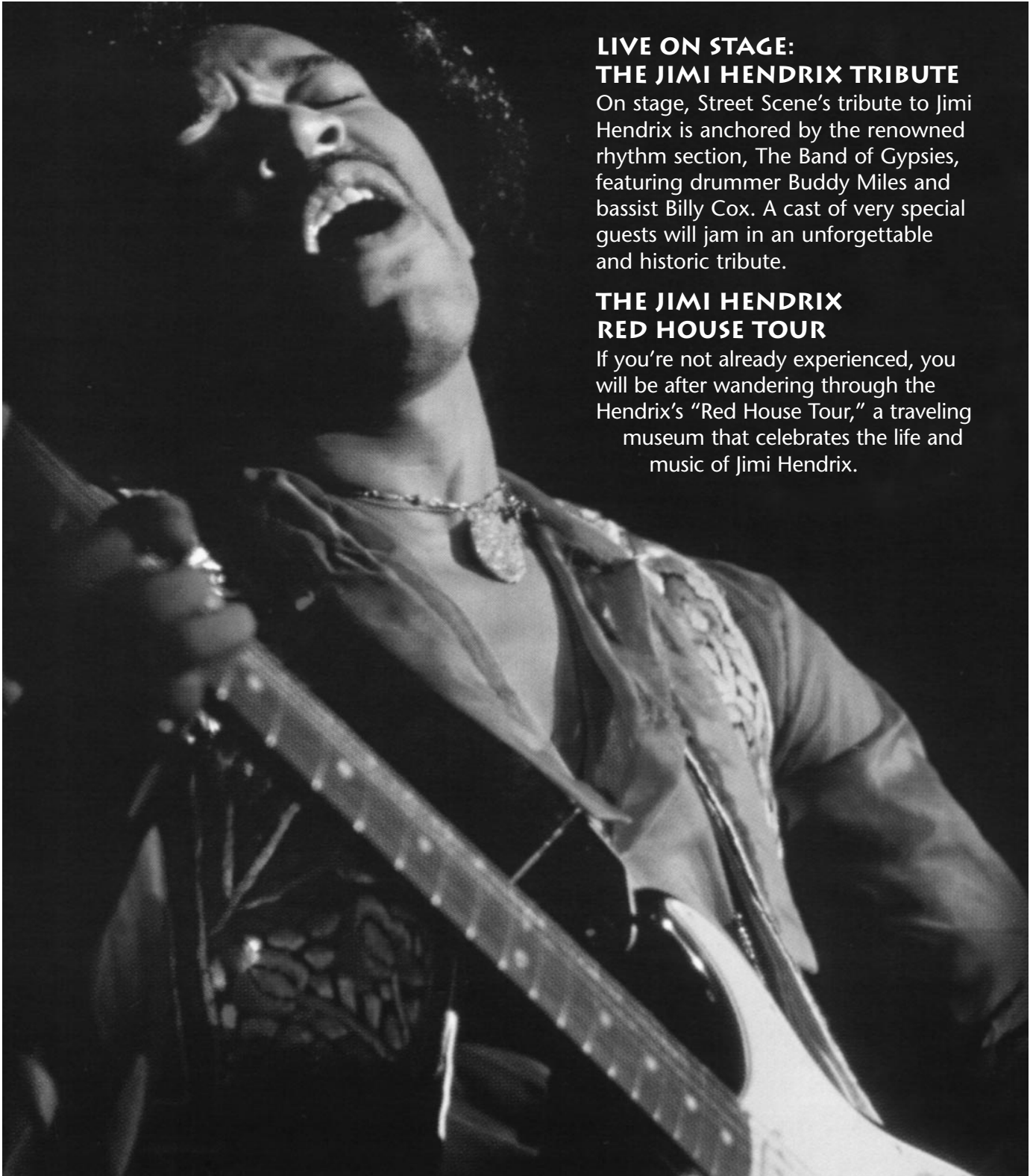

If you're not already experienced, you will be after wandering through the Hendrix's "Red House Tour," a traveling museum that celebrates the life and music of Jimi Hendrix.

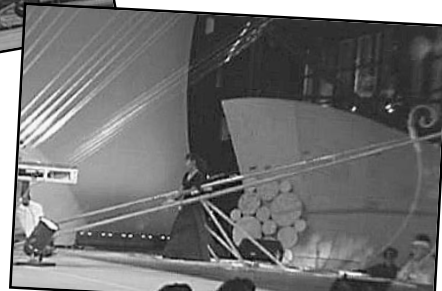


### THE MAGICAL EARTH HARP

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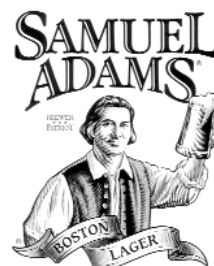

Street parking is available in the area surrounding STREET SCENE, which is bordered on the north by Market Street, on the south by Harbor Drive, on the east by Ninth Street, and on the west by 4th Avenue. You are strongly encouraged to park in outlying lots and ride the Trolley or Carpool into Downtown San Diego.
